All architecture from the Middle Ages to the beginning of the 20th century is marked by the technique of mouth-blown glass. Used in windows, blown glass has, over the centuries, imprinted a unique vibration and relief, signing the aesthetics of the facades of the period. Over time, technical progress — in particular a better command of the melting process and of raw materials — gradually transformed the appearance of windows through:

- the structures, with larger pane formats bringing more light into the building;
- the transparency and tint of the glass, through the reduction of imperfections (oxides);
- the relief and vibration of the glass, through the greater or lesser presence of bubbles and cords.

Specialising in glass for the windows of historic buildings, MP Vitrage provides a solution for your high-end restoration projects: Historic® glass. An authentic mouth-blown glass, Historic® glass is made by one of the last blown-glass manufacturers in Europe and processed in our workshop. Cut to size, it is then assembled into double glazing for a perfect integration into old joinery, or made into laminated safety glass, according to your needs.

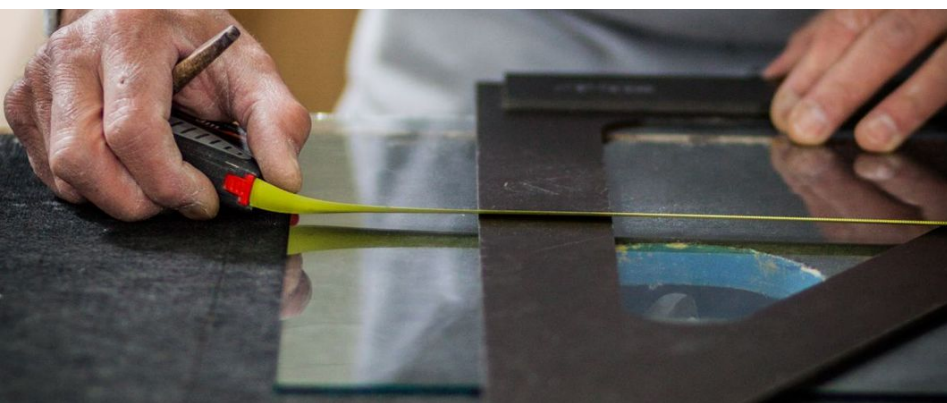
The processing of the glass in our workshop is entirely done by hand, which guarantees quality and costs, while meeting the most demanding lead times.

By bringing life to the window, Historic® glass restores the charm and prestige of the buildings of the past:

- It can be body-tinted from a palette of colours, or specially made from a sample (on request).
- With a thickness ranging from 2 to 4 mm, it offers a wide aesthetic choice, through the greater or lesser presence of bubbles and movements in the material.
